## 07.200 Admissions

07.201 <u>Establishing Admissions Policies</u>. Each Institution shall adopt admissions policies consistent with admission standards set by the Board and publish them in accordance

with Regents Rule 07.110.

07.202 <u>Admission Requirements</u>. The Board shall set admission standards for each Institution consistent with the

standards for each Institution consistent with the requirements of Chapter 51 of the Texas Education Code, other applicable federal and state law, and Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board Rules. The policies governing admission to academic programs shall be designed to maximize opportunity and access for all

Texans, within parameters established by applicable laws.

Automatic Admission. In accordance with Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board Rules and Texas Education Code § 51.803, each general academic institution shall grant automatic admission to in-state undergraduate students who graduate in the top 10% of their high school graduating class. The Board delegates to the President of each general academic institution the authority to determine for each academic year, in accordance with the requirements set forth in Texas Education Code § 51.804, whether automatic admission to the Institution shall be granted to in-state first-time freshman students who

graduate in the top 25% of their high school graduating

class.

Chancellor for review and approval by the Board.
